Flying field

Mengeško-Kamniško polje (17 km NW of Ljubljana) N 46° 11' 38,17" , E 14° 34' 45,63"

Reserve terrain: IG near Ljubljana (9 km SE) 45° 57' 32" N, 14° 31' 44" E

Terrain: Mengeško Kamniško polje East- West 1,5 km, North-South 2,5 km nearly free of obstacles, villages rather far away, landing path for Ljubljana airport at 6 km distance. Second flying field is Ljubljana Ig North-south 2 km, East-West 2 km, free of obstacles, mostly grass, villages at the limits of the field.

The municipality Mengeš and the inhabitants of the surrounding villages strongly support the organizers in the preparations and realization of the events, offering assistance and they will assure the use of even larger area of flying space if needed.

Weather: The prevailing character of weather in July is dry continental. Average day temperature in July is 25 – 30 ° C with light wind. Usually that month is without significant rainfall.

Competition: All competitions will be held according to the FAI Sporting Rules: Code valid in 2012. Any local rule will be announced in the next bulletins.

Participation: Teams (three competitors in each class – F1A, F1B, F1P, one team manager, one assistant team manager, two timekeepers) from FAI affiliated National Aero Club. Individual Junior World Champions 2010 will also be invited to participate in 2012 Junior World Championships for Free Flight. Supporters, helpers, translators to official languages and spectators are welcome. Each competitor and each time manager must possess FAI sporting License valid for 2012.

Official: Official languages will be English, German and Slovenian.

Awards: FAI medals and diploma and cups will be awarded to the winner, second and third place competitors in each class F1A, F1B and F1P and to the winning, second and third place teams in each class F1A, F1B and F1P.

The following perpetual trophies will be awarded:

- F1A Individual - Gabriel ROBINET Challenge – current holder Denis Sinskiy (Russia)
- F1B Individual - Pyotr BALABUYEV Memorial Challenge Trophy – current holder Skibicki Bartlomiej (Poland)
- F1C/J/P Individual - UKRAINE Power Challenge Trophy – current holder Cymtro Sadomov (Ukraine)
- F1A Team - UKRAINE Junior Challenge Trophy – current holder Sweden
- F1C/J/P Team - UKRAINE Junior Challenge Trophy – current holder Ukraine
- General Classification for classes F1A/F1B/F1P - Challenge France – current holder Ukraine

Entry fee: Competitors: **230 EUR** for each category
Team managers, assistant team managers: **180 EUR**
Supporters, helpers: **45 EUR**
Payment deadline: **April, 1st 2012**
Entry deadline : **April, 1st 2012**

The entry fee covers participation in the Junior World Championships, trophies and gifts. The organizer will encourage early payments with benefits (prior to entry deadline) and will demand progressive penalties for payments after the entry deadline. **Payment is possible only by Bank, cash payment is not possible.**

Timekeepers: Organizers will provide necessary number of local timekeepers. Each participating country may enter a timekeeper and these timekeepers will be given precedence over the locals. The intention to enter a timekeeper should be announced in the Entry Form. On demand organizers will provide accommodation and meals for timekeepers during the full official period of the competition. All these timekeepers should speak one of the official languages, preferably English, and have own binocular, tripod and stopwatch.

Model Processing: Upon arrival, each team will be able to choose time for model processing from the timetable provided by the organizers.

Anti – Doping: If for medical conditions a competitor has to take any of the substances listed on the WADA Prohibited List then he must have a Therapeutic Use Exemption from the FAI.

Accommodation: The Mengeško Kamniška region has tourist center with different accommodation options. In the vicinity (9 km) there is the Spa hotel Snovik with accommodation facilities of different levels. The small hotel Harmonia Mengeš will be occupied by timekeepers and technical staff of organizers. Additional accommodation possibilities can be found within the range of 20 km in surrounds of Mengeš with a similar tourist offer.

SPA Hotel Snovik = 30,00 EUR / pro person double room + breakfast

Harmonia Mengeš = 30,00 EUR / pro person double room + breakfast

Exactly offers and possibility of application will be published in Bulletin No. 2.

Meals: All accommodation options near the competition area can offer meals. Organizers will provide additional warm food (beef goulash, grill steak, chicken legs, ect.) and 1 non alcohol drink **gratis** for competitors, team managers and helpers at the competitor days. Lunch packages will be available at the competitor field (price 3 – 5 EUR). Food and beverages will be offered on the field, too.

About Country: The Republic of Slovenia is a member of the European Union. For citizens from other countries in addition to a valid travel document, Schengen visa is required to enter Slovenia. The organizer will help participants in obtaining visas with issuing invitations, certificates and other documents.

Currency: Euro is the official currency in Slovenia. Foreign currency exchange is possible in banks, exchange offices, post offices, hotels, gas stations and other places. Most shops and services accept all major credit/debit cards (Eurocard / Mastercard, Visa, American Express, Maestro...).

Security: Slovenia is quite a safe country with a relatively low rate of criminal activities. However, organizers will take additional measures in order to increase security of participants and their properties.

National Anthem&Flag: Each team is requested to bring at registration two national flags and CD with the national anthem. These will be returned before departure.
